Aaliyah is back to learn with you Seerah once again! Now you know that Abu Taalib still feared for his nephew as the Quraish were still planning and plotting to kill the Messenger of Allaah. So Abu Taalib called all his tribe people Bani Hashim, Bani Muttaalib and sons of Abd Munaf and asked them to defend and protect his nephew and all of them responded to him and promised to take care of Muhammad. from the harms of the Quraish.

- 7. By the permission of Allaah some Makkans were very angry with Abu Jahl and the Quraish for such a harsh treatment to their relations and they forced the Quraish to end this Boycott and allow Muhammad and his people to enter Makkah......
- 8. The General Social Boycott happened during the 7th year of the prophet hood and ended by the 10th year of the prophet hood......

So now back again in Makkah Abu Taalib was still worried about his nephew and Abu Taalib now fell ill and was feeling weak due to old age. This worried him more. He was worried that the Quraish would kill his nephew after his death. And the Quraish were worried that people would blame them for the weakness and the sickness of Abu Taalib. So they yet again tried to ask Abu Taalib to ask Muhammad to stop calling people to Allaah but Muhammad did did not agree.


