

alc ate on the earth was bread which he made from sowing and harvesting the 7 grains of wheat Jibreel


alc brought from the same forbidden tree that Aadam

- Shape of a Circle to trace
- Pencil

How to do

- Place the circle shape onto the paper and trace it
- Cut the tissue papers into small squares
- Scrunch the tissue squares and make a paper ball
- Dip the paper ball into the glue
- Place the glue dipped green and blue paper squares on the white paper within the traced circle shape
- Fill the Circle shape with green and blue tissue paper
- You will have a beautiful Tissue Paper Globe


